De Denne YE competition entries

We are changing the categories under which entries are submitted to the De Denne competition.

We have also re-designed the entry forms which will be available on the YE website. Please use these for 2018 entries and destroy any previous versions. Thank you.

Categories

Group

Individual

Children must hold a valid membership of Young Embroiderers as at 1 September in order to enter the De Denne competition. Their membership number(s) must be shown on the entry form.

Please make sure the relevant entry form(s) are completed and sent in with the work.

Age-groups

5-8 years

9-12 years

13+ years.

Group

- This is where the YE group members have worked together and contributed to the final piece. Not every child in the group has to take part – only if they wish to.
- The final piece must make up a "complete" single picture. Each child can contribute in whatever way the group wishes.
- The final piece can be one single piece of work or it may be made up of "composite" parts but these must, when viewed together, create a single picture. Please number each piece on the back, with 1 as top left,
- The age group to be entered will be determined by the average age of all the children who have contributed to the piece.

Individual - There are two ways to enter this category

1. If your Group entry is made up of "composite" pieces of work, and if each of those is **also** a piece that can stand alone, then that piece can be entered for an Individual category as well. Make sure it is clearly labelled on the back with the child's name, age, membership number and title of piece (if applicable)
2. Alternatively, the YE member can create their own piece of work which stands alone and submit this for the Individual category.

BOTH CATEGORIES - A piece of work can be entered into **both** categories under the guidelines given above

I have given some examples to show this.

One example is of a complete picture (fig A) then another example of the same picture (fig B) made up of composite pieces.

No matter which way you decide to do it, a "complete picture" (Fig A) can be entered as a Branch entry.

If the branch entry was made up of composite parts, (Fig B) and each of these is an image in itself, they can also be entered in the Individual categories according to the child's age.

The individual entries will be submitted to the correct age group according to the age of the child on 1 September.
